- 50 miles from SMASH site
- Minority*

MOSTEC

School: Massachusetts Institute of Technology

- Current HS Junior
- US Citizens/Permanent Residents
- First-Generation*
- Minority*
- Low-income*

Cornell Curie Academy

School: Cornell University
